



Travel information Castellon 2010

Our this year's skydiving trip is taking us again (since 1993) to Castellon at the Spanish Mediterranean coast. The plane provided will be Beech 99 like last year. It is the fastest skydiver's plane in Europe and we will be in 4000+ m in record time.

Programme

- Jumping days from 19th March to 27th March 2010
- Relative work course 21st to 26th March 2010 (150,00 Euro plus instructor jumps partial)
- Team training – please register in advance – by AERO coaching team and members of the national team

- AFF – instructor preparation course from 21st to 26th March

- 12-way: organised jumps in a fixed group (you should be able to fly every slot in a 12-way) with player coach and video (100,-- Euro incl. Player coach, videoslot and –fee)
- from 21st to 26th March 2010; first come, first serve

- Wingsuit camp with Mirko Schmidt and Harry Kloska (20th to 27th March 2010 – 50,-- Euro plus jumps)

- Freeflycamp with Tim Porter (He's been in Castellon last year and during the freefly week in Calden as well) This camp is supposed to attract freeflyers who are already a bit advanced (at least sitfly) 150,-- Euro plus your jumps and instructor jumps partial

And of course fun jumps whole day long..

This trip is suitable for beginners as well. Here you can increase your numbers of jumps and your experience while having much fun. Experience skydivers and especially teams will have the opportunity to make a lot of jumps – short ways, no taxi time, no problems with airtraffic clearances will guarantee professional skydiving days.

Arrival

Your trip you have to organise by yourself. There are several possibilities: by car on good motorways (from Freiburg approx. 1.200 km). Many low cost carriers fly to Valencia, Barcelona and Reus. There you can rent a car, drive to Castellon and return the car there. Rented cars are quite cheap during that time of the year.

Dropzone

A nice dropzone, which is run almost all the year by Skytime Castellon. There are a small bar, where food and beverages are available, toilets, skydive shop etc.

Accomodation

Since 14 years we have been booking our rooms in the Hotel Intur Azor. This hotel with bar and big lobby is also the headquarter of the event. Here the skydivers meet in the evenings for drinks, gambling, video of the day and also for team or course conferences. The hotel is situated in Benicasim, 50 m from beach and 5 km from the dropzone. There is a shuttle every morning and afternoon; the route is also a perfect way to have your daily work out jogging, skating or to go by bicycle

Team coaching	150.-- Euro per team and day

Accomodation costs and course fees should be payed in advance. On the dropzone you can pay only cash. Unused tickets can be returned.
